Converting to Illustrator/ Stitch Cuts

The Mimaki Paper Cutter uses **Abode Illustrator** to print. **Before** your appointment, your file must be set up correctly.

1. Divide your file into **3 Layers (Cut Outer, Cut Inner and Stitch Cut)** Maker sure your model lines do not exceed your material size.

2. Stitch Cuts/ Dashed Lines

a. Select the lines accordingly and make it dashed

lines in Illustrator by setting it's brush definition. (Properties>Stroke>Dashed Lines)

b. Select the dashed lines and make its **weight (thickness) 0.01pt.** This will prevent the Mimaki from cutting noticeable double lines.

c. With the dashed lines selected, choose: Object>Flatten Transparency

-Then set the Raster/Vector Balance at **100**, by moving the slider all the way to **VECTOR**

3. Select all and Export as: Abode Illustrator
